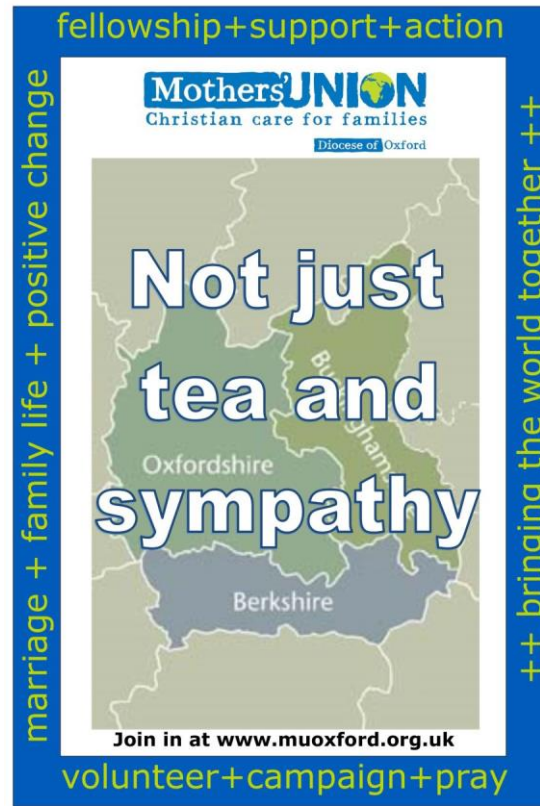
A dynamic charity putting God's love into action;

Supporting all families.

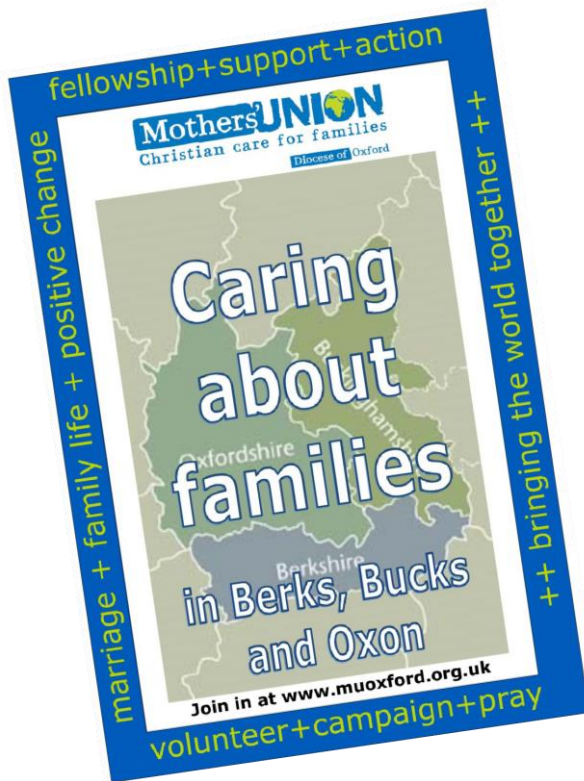
Since 1876, Mothers' Union has shared God's love for the world by encouraging, strengthening and supporting marriage and family life in all its variety.
