

LAMB FOR CRÈME EGGS KNITTING PATTERN

Materials

3.25 mm/10 knitting needles. Double knit yarn oddments.

Abbreviations

Garner stitch – knit every row; Rib – Knit 1 Purl 1; K2tog – knit 2 stitches together; Inc 1, knit into front and back of next stitch.

Method

Body. Cast on 12 stitches and work 7 rows in K1,P1 rib. Inc 1stitch at each end of the 8th row (14 stitches). Knit in garner stitch till work measures 3.5 inches, then on next row K2tog, knit to last 2 stitches and K2tog. (12 stitches) Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib then cast off in rib.

Head

Cast on 2 stitches and continue in garner stitch, increasing in the first stitch of each row until you have 12 stitches. Then knit two rows without increasing, before knitting the first two stitches together in each row until 2 stitches remain. Knit these together.

Tail

Cast on 8 stitches then cast off, leaving enough yarn to attach tail to body.

Making Up Lamb

Fold the body over in half, right sides together and sew sides. Turn to right side. Fold the head diagonally to make a triangle, then sew contrast eyes before sewing round edges. Squeeze top corners and wind yarn round to make ear shapes and sew securely. Sew head to body and attach the tail.

Do use whatever wool you have available. I've taken a photo of some I've knitted.

Labels will be available to attach to the back/inside the sheep.
